The EfM (Education for Ministry) NZ Trust Board is seeking to broaden its profile and is looking for someone who is excited about theological education and will assist the board in meeting their strategic goals.

An ideal candidate would be a person who is interested in communication and project facilitation and promotion. One who is a team player, working alongside EfM mentors and trainers, board members, ministry educators and other stake holders, and who also enjoys working solo on administrative and financial tasks. Many of the tasks involve online communication and administration and so the person can be based at home anywhere in Aotearoa/New Zealand, but some travel is required.

Theological qualifications are not necessary but experience in applied theology/Christian ministry would be an advantage. The ability to connect and build relationships, especially in a Christian church context is important. Experience with use of websites, designing comms material and an interest in developing and increasing the profile and membership of EfM are key expectations.

Education for Ministry is an ecumenical adult learning programme designed to link Christian faith with daily life, and to deepen Christian discipleship. It combines scholarly and systematic Bible study and education in theology and church history, with small group worship, prayer and community building. It is a model developed at the University of the South, Sewanee, TN USA. The EfM NZ Trust Board has a contract with the University of the South to run the programme, with a component designed specifically for the Church in Aotearoa New Zealand.
